

Policy for Associate Readers

From July 26th 2016 the following will apply –

Associate membership of the University Library entitles the user to borrow up to 5 books at a time for a period of either one week or four weeks dependent on the loan status of the book. Should the book be in high demand, there is a possibility that the book will be recalled at any time. Membership lasts for 1 year. Services such as Inter-library loans, IT and media facilities are NOT available to Associate Readers.

The following categories of reader may register with the University Library and become Associate Readers:

Without charge

- Former staff of the University and its predecessor institutions; academic or academic related staff at the University of Hull and FE colleges in Lincolnshire & East Yorkshire
- Former students of the University (*Alumni Association members are not required to apply in writing - please contact the library desk)

On payment of an annual fee of £20

- Serving teachers in Lincolnshire and East Yorkshire*
- Employees of Social Services in Lincolnshire and East Yorkshire*
- Employees of the NHS in Lincolnshire *
- Other members of the public may be allowed to join at the discretion of the University Librarian

*Proof of employment will be required

Without charge, for reference purposes only

- Students enrolled at other institutions in Lincolnshire and East Yorkshire
- Students enrolled with the Open University (OU)
- Students from other institutions on production of proof of enrolment
- Members of the public at local discretion

(Please note: although resources are available for the use of associate members, priority must always be given to University students and staff)
